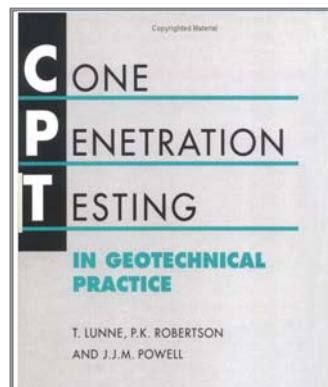


## Aussies in Abundance at CPT'10 Conference
